USF Conditional Application Procedure

1. Carefully read all the information in the brochure.
2. Complete the application form on the reverse side. Be sure to mark the English program to which you are applying and *sign* the application. Your name must be written exactly the same as **it appears** in your passport.
3. Send the following:
 - a) The completed and signed application form
 - b) If requesting an I-20, a current (not more than 6 months old) bank statement or letter of financial support for the minimum sum of U.S. \$8,000.
 - c) U.S. \$100 (non-refundable application fee). All checks must be drawn on a U.S. bank and made payable to the University of South Florida. If you are also applying for conditional admission to the University of South Florida, you will need to include a separate U.S. \$30 non-refundable application fee that will be forwarded to the university. (This fee cannot be paid online at this moment.)

5. Upon approval of the application, the English Language Institute will send you an admission packet with the admission and placement testing letter, information about registration and medical insurance, the I-20 Form, and instructions to obtain the F-1 student visa.

Refund Policy

Students who have registered for any of the programs and who attend only up to the fifth day of classes can receive a refund of 80% of the tuition. The ELI must receive the request for a refund in writing no later than the fifth day of classes. After the fifth day of classes, no refunds or transfers to the following semesters will be made.

The \$100.00 application fee charged to process applications is non-refundable.
